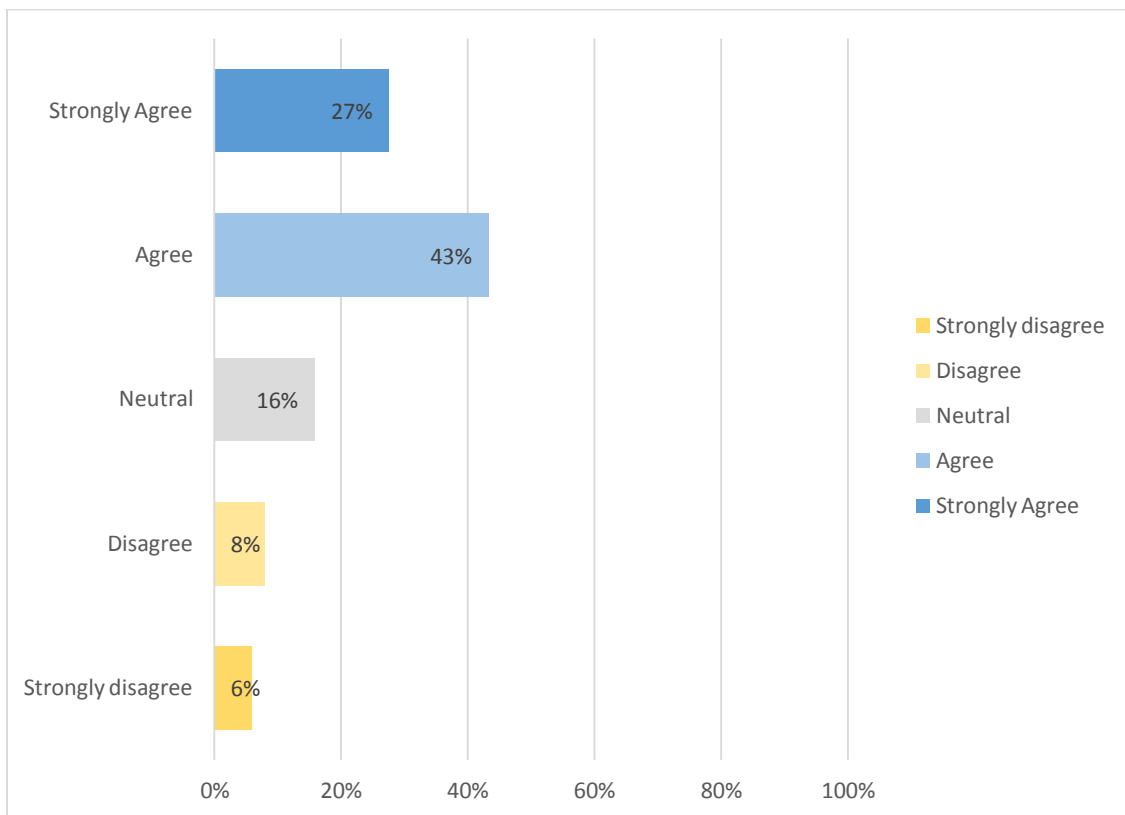

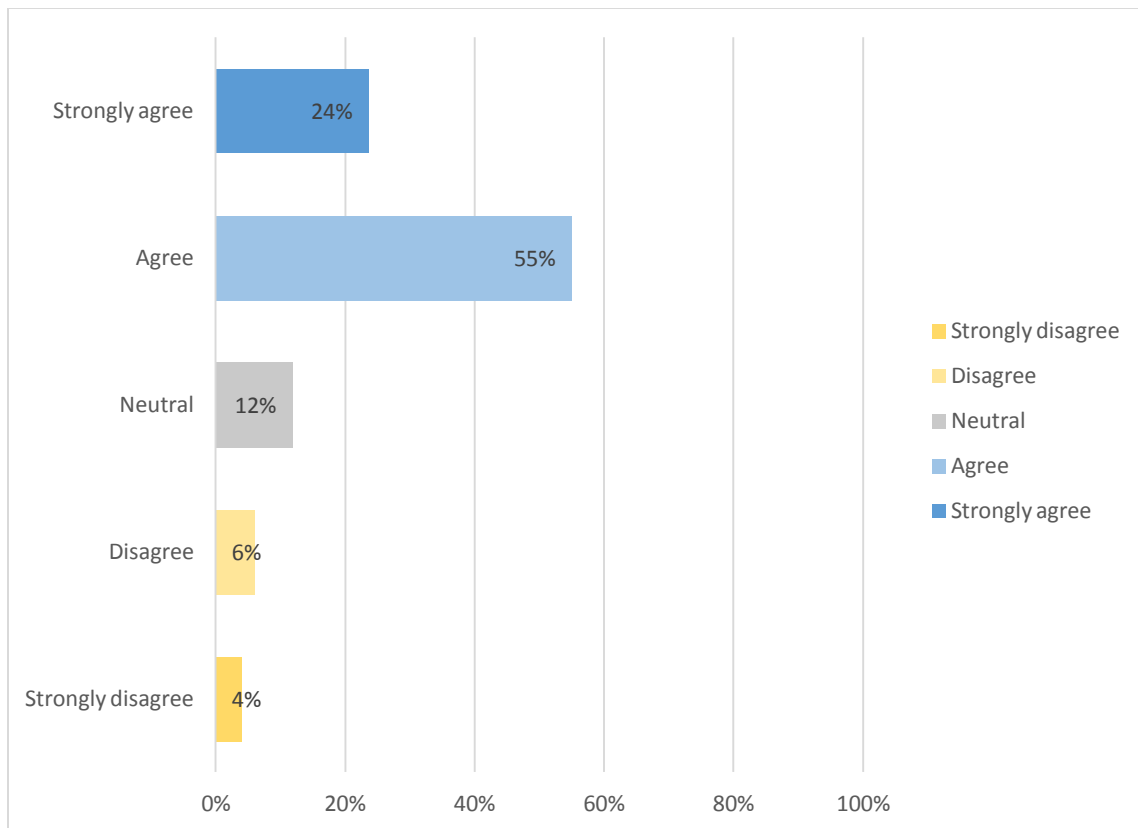


MALTA SHARING DIVERSITY QUESTIONNAIRE

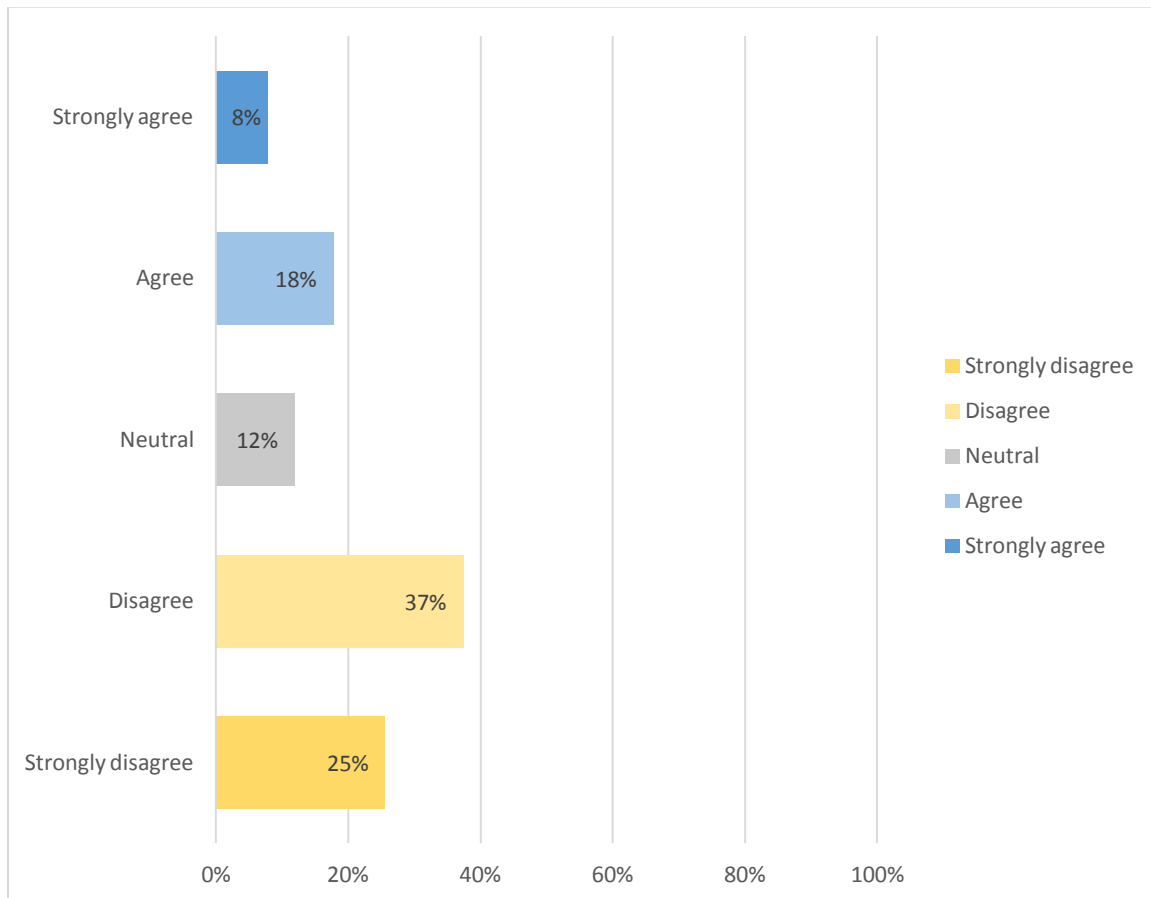
1. Migration to and from Malta has been occurring since recorded history, bringing along a mixture of cultures and races that have formed our rich heritage and identity as a country.



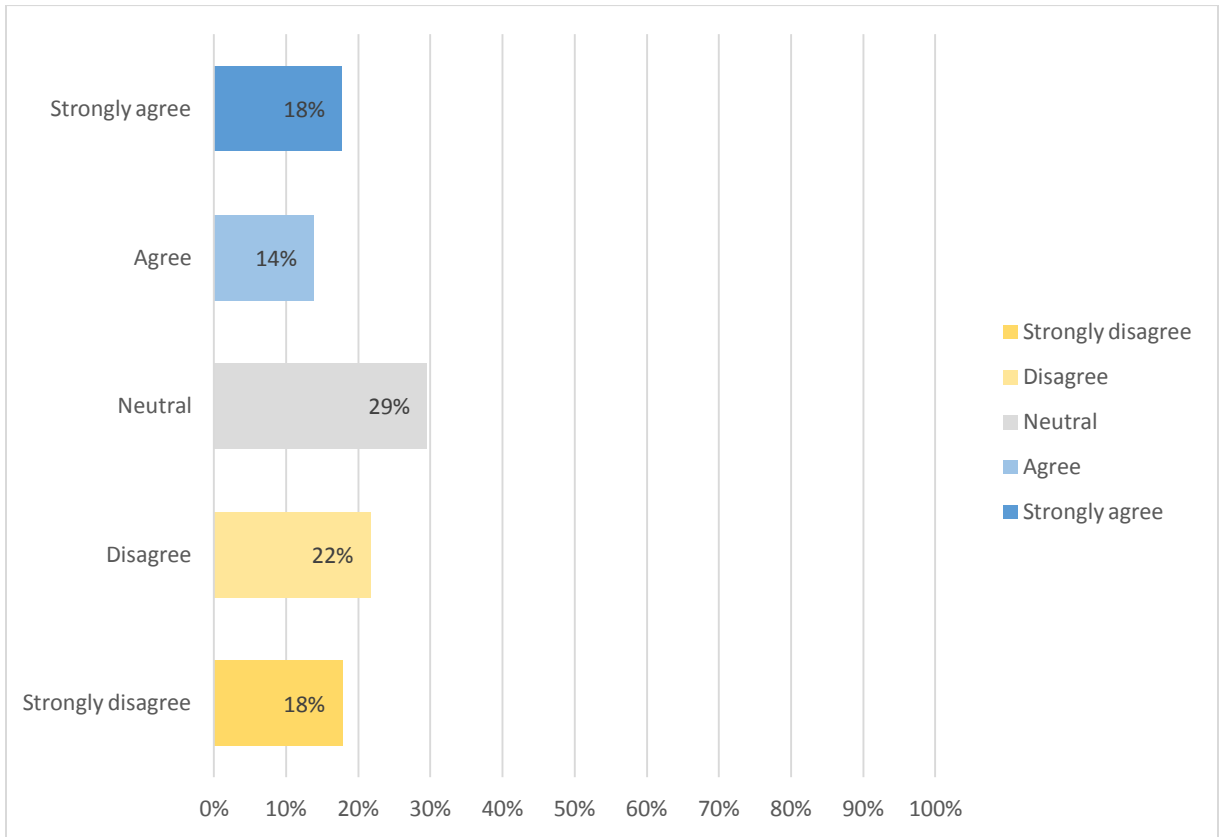
2. Intercultural dialogue's main aim is to develop a deeper understanding between diverse cultures, thus enhancing integration whilst living in harmony as a community.



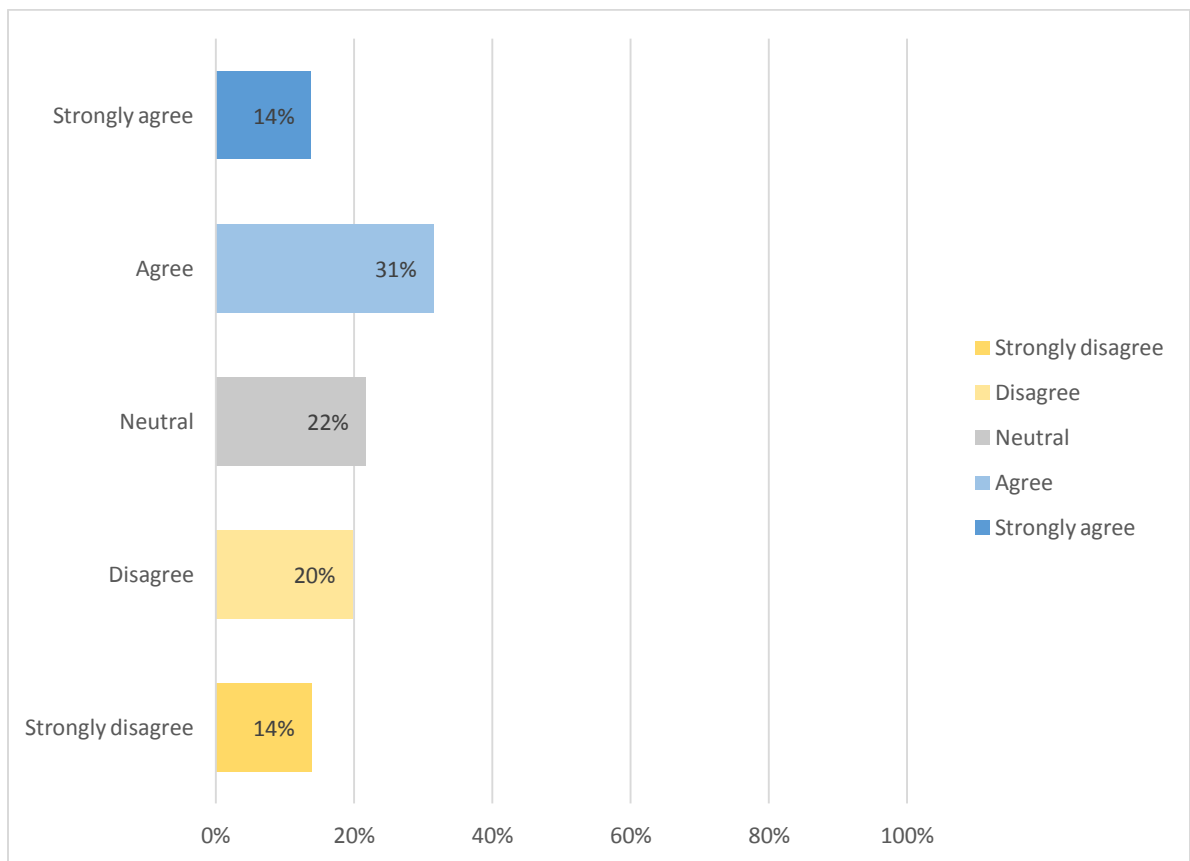
3. Integration does not work, never has and it never will because the migrants want to impose their culture on us.



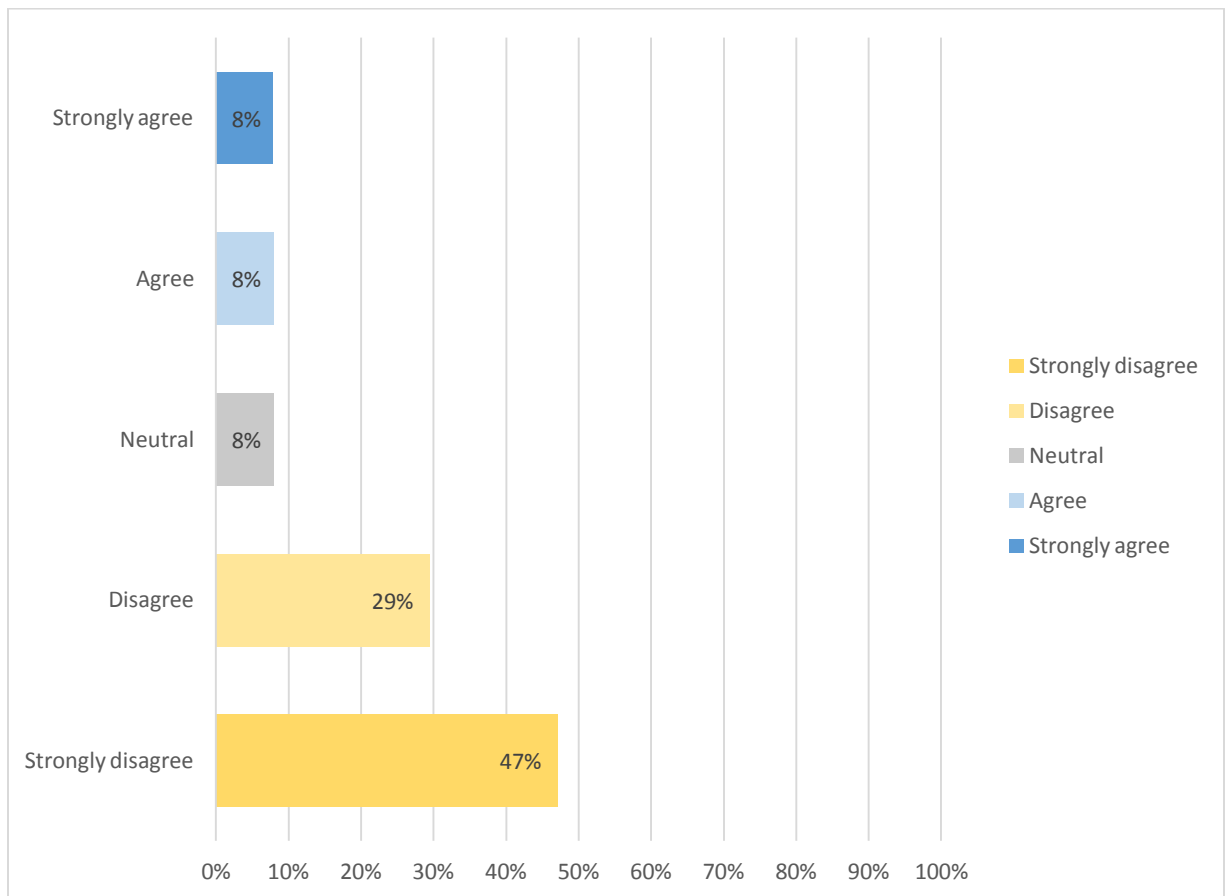
4. I do not feel safe with all the migrants coming in my country.



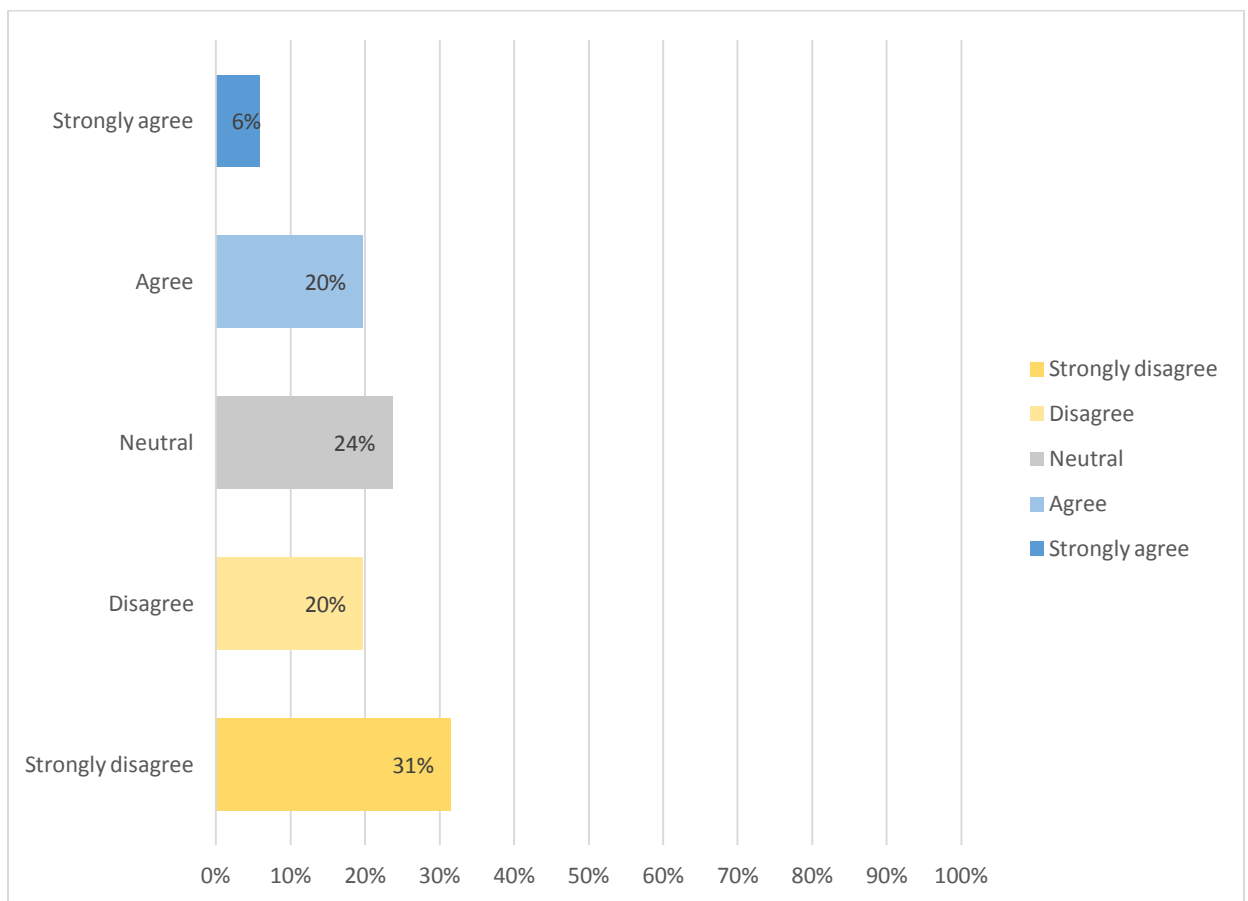
5. I have no problem if migrants were to become my neighbours.



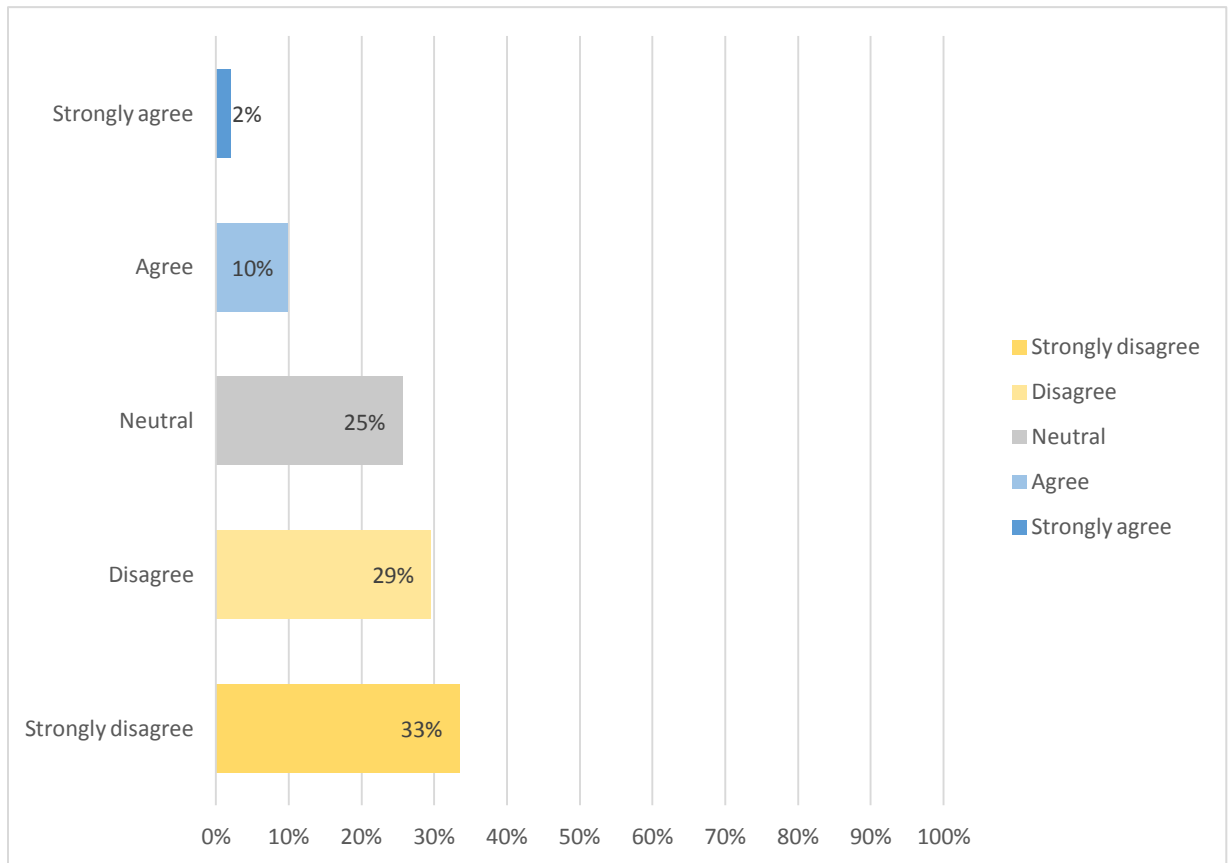
6. Malta is a Catholic country and with all the migrants coming I am afraid that we will all become Muslims.



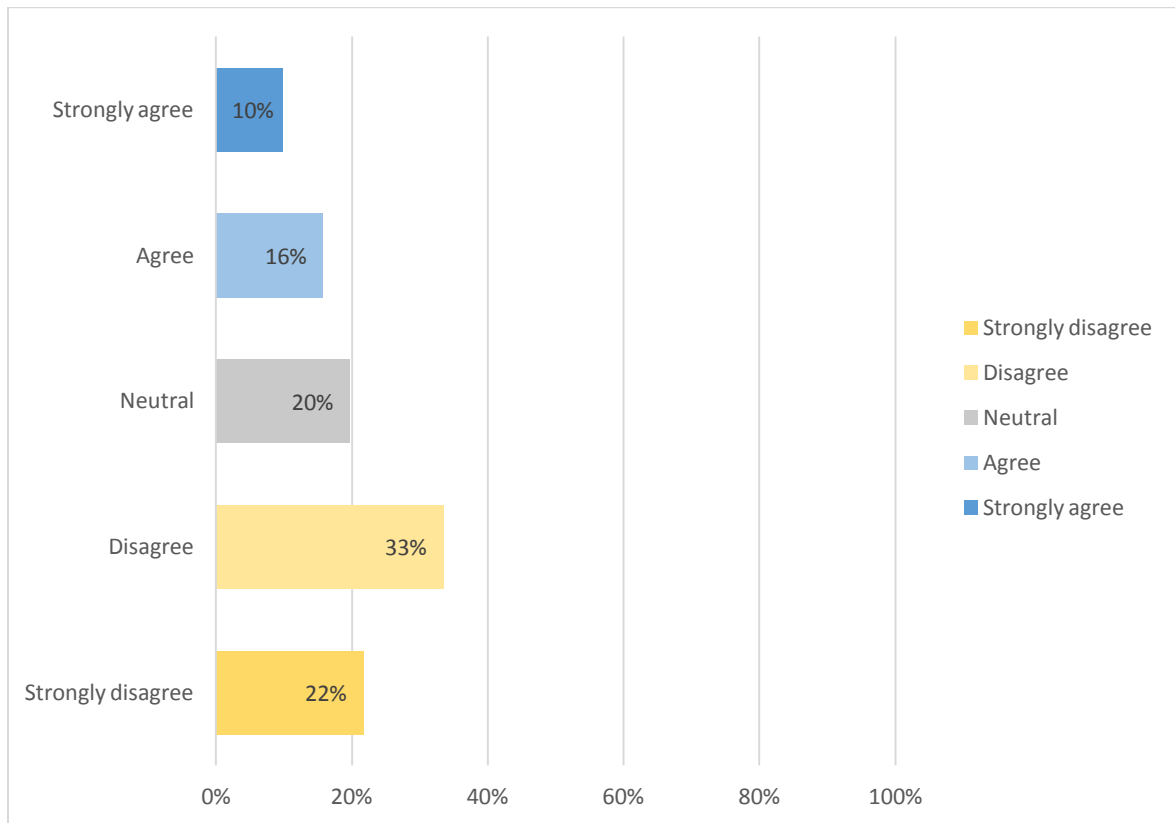
7. I am against intermarriages; I would strongly oppose to any of my children marrying a migrant with a different cultural background than ours.



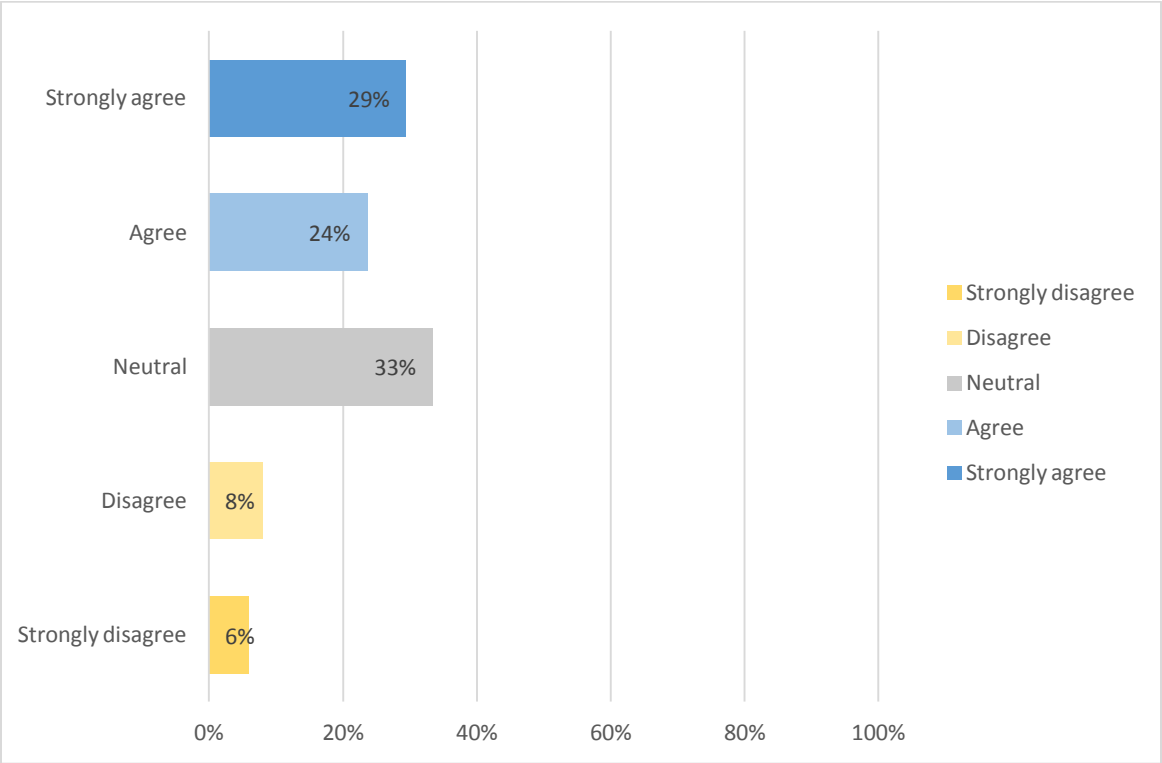
8. I have had several bad experiences with migrants.



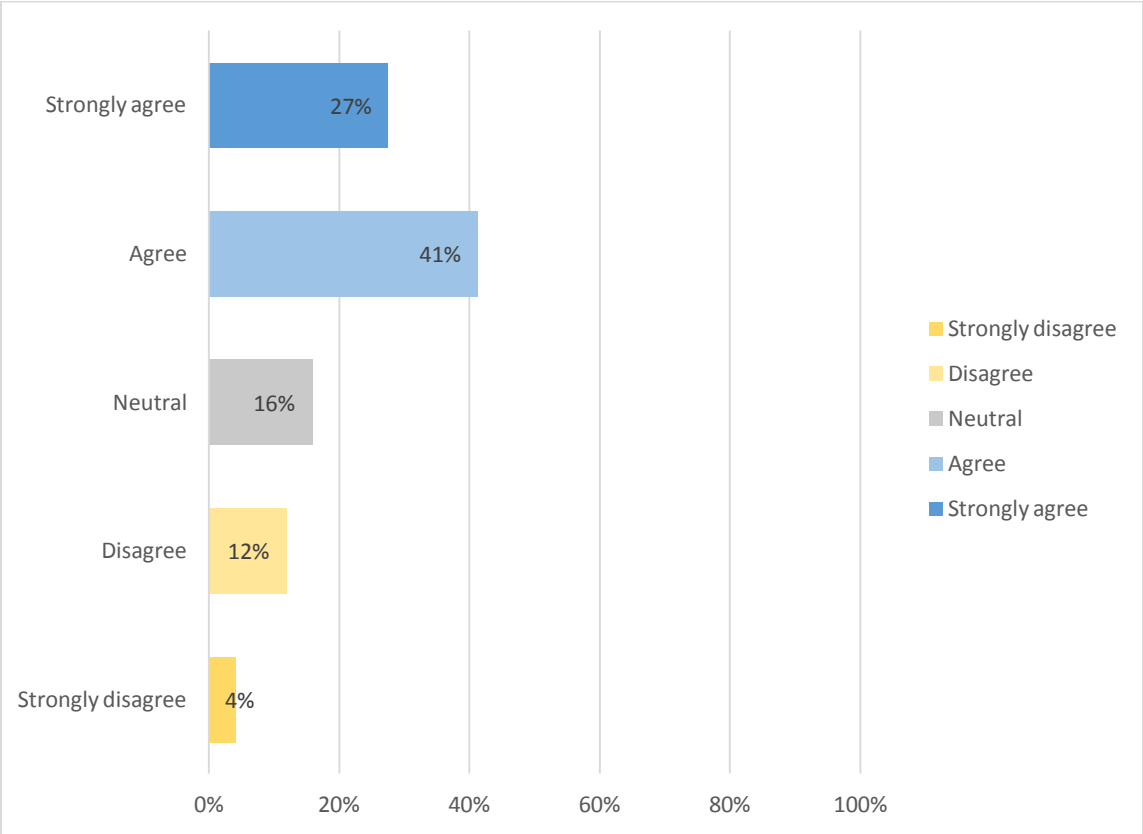
9. In my opinion, migrants are a potential source of conflict, crime and disease.



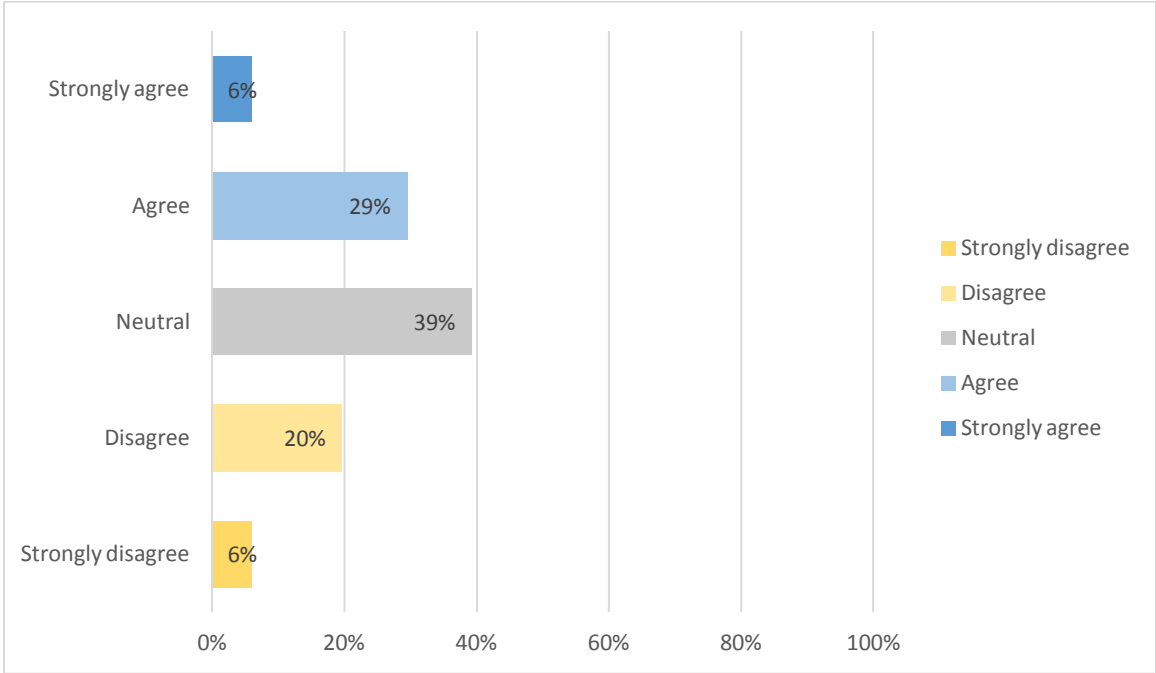
10. I have friends who are migrants with different cultural backgrounds than mine and we get along very well.



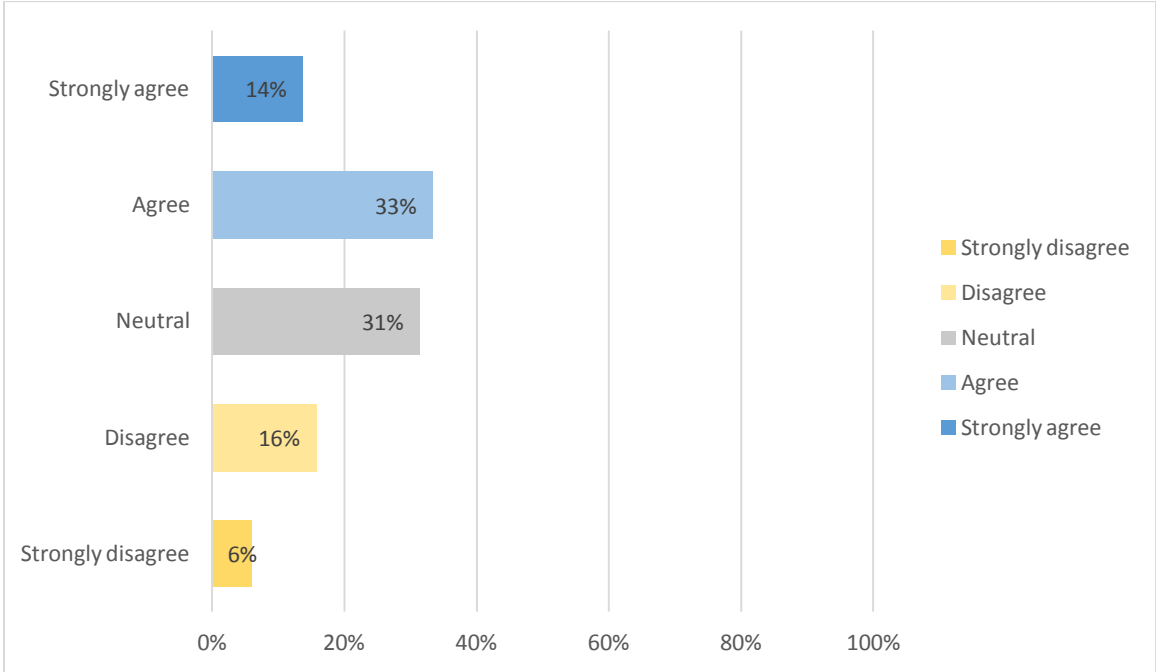
11. The variety of food and language which we can enjoy, the ability to connect with other cultures and learn other customs, speak in favour of multiculturalism.



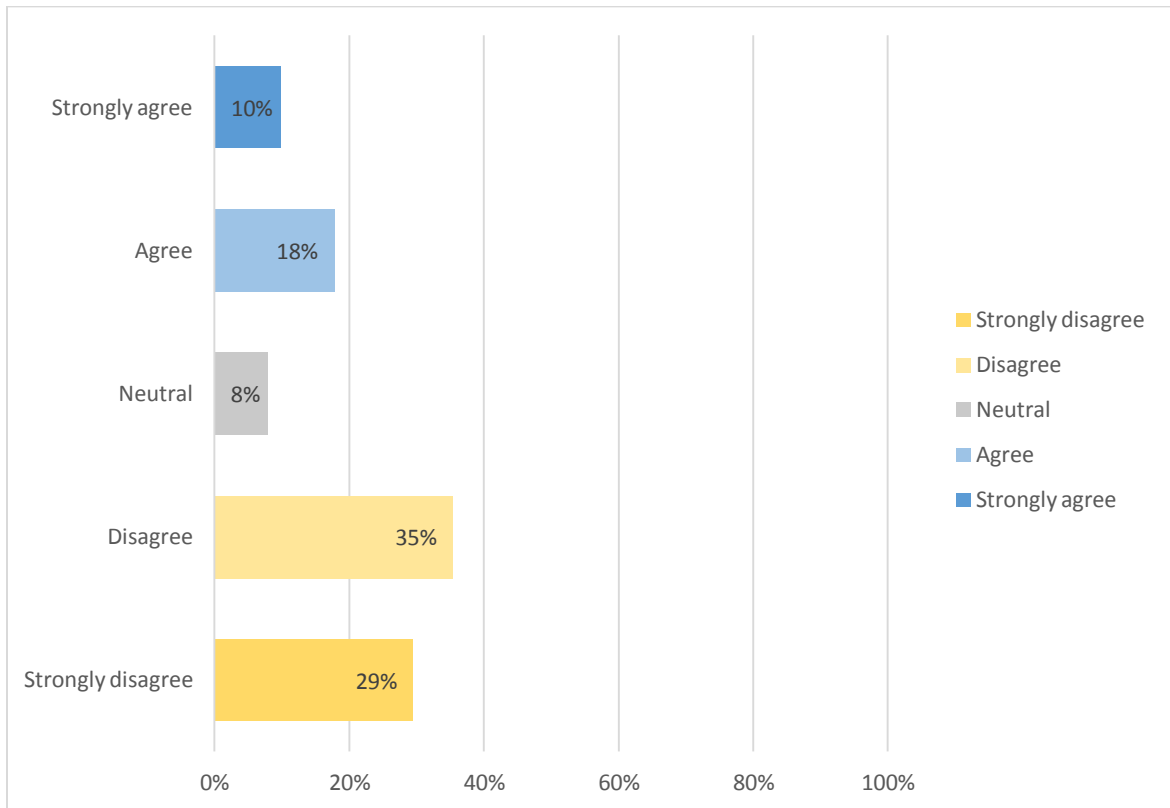
12. Migrants are willing to integrate with the Maltese.



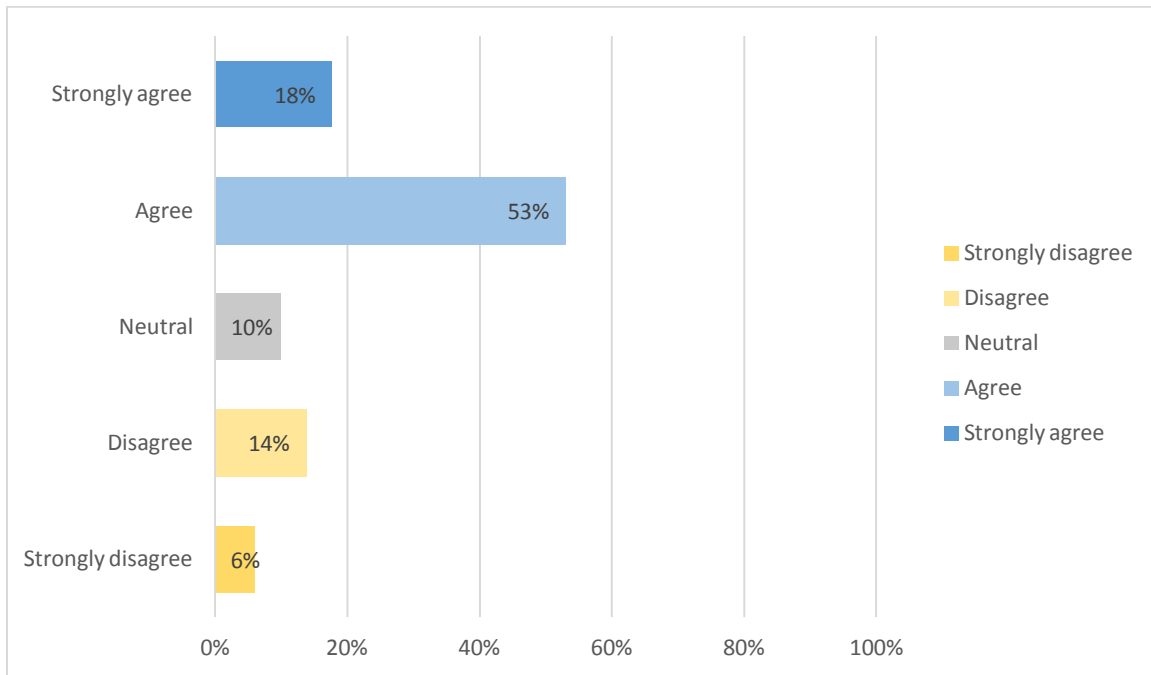
13. I am all for integration as long as the migrants conform to our Society.



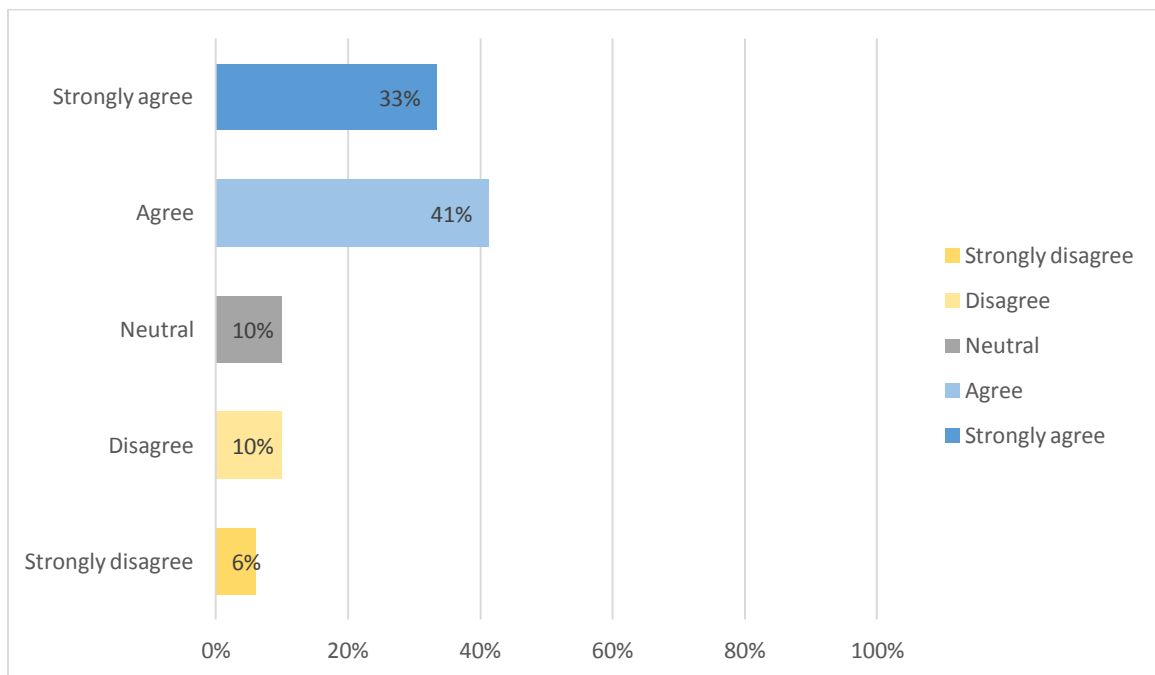
14. Migrants are invading us and do not have any intention of integrating with us.



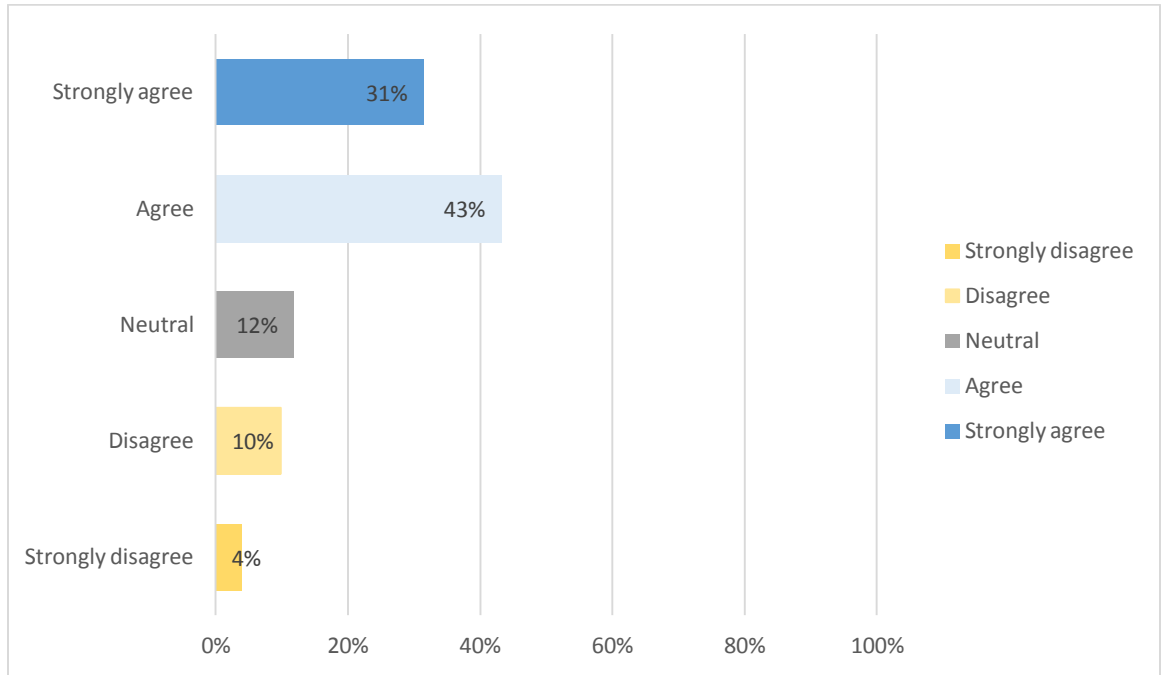
15. We can live in harmony as one community even though we do not have the same cultural background.



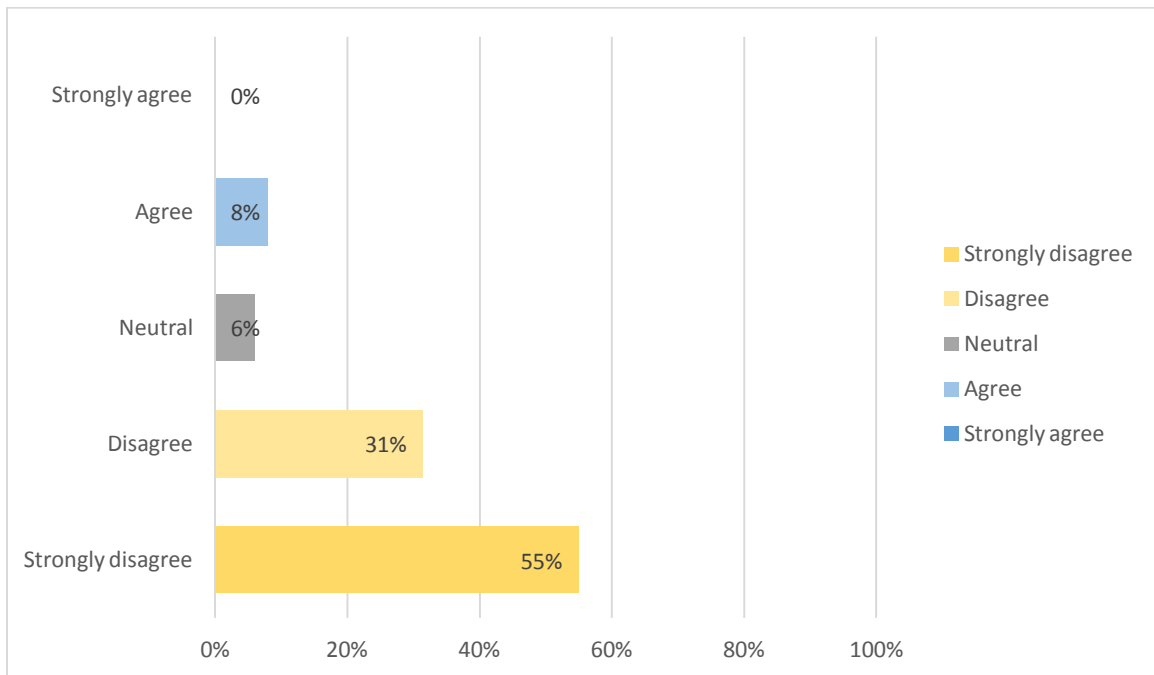
16. I do not have any problem if my colleagues at work are migrants.



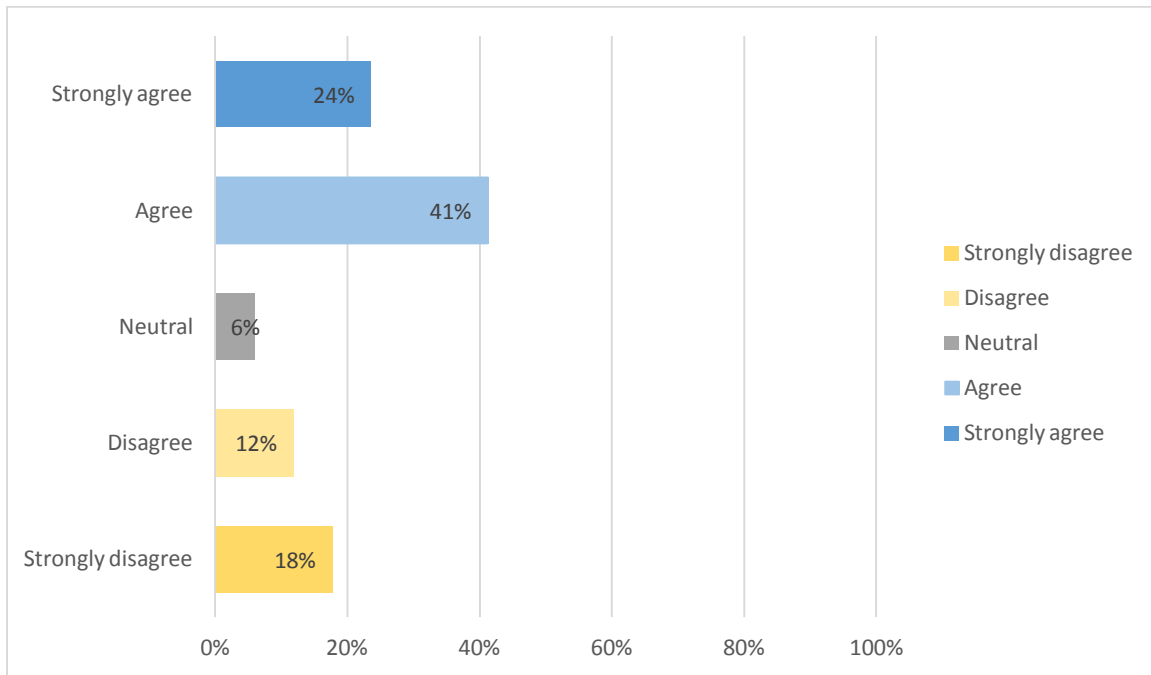
17. Employers are taking advantage of the migrants and exploit them for very low wages and substandard working conditions.



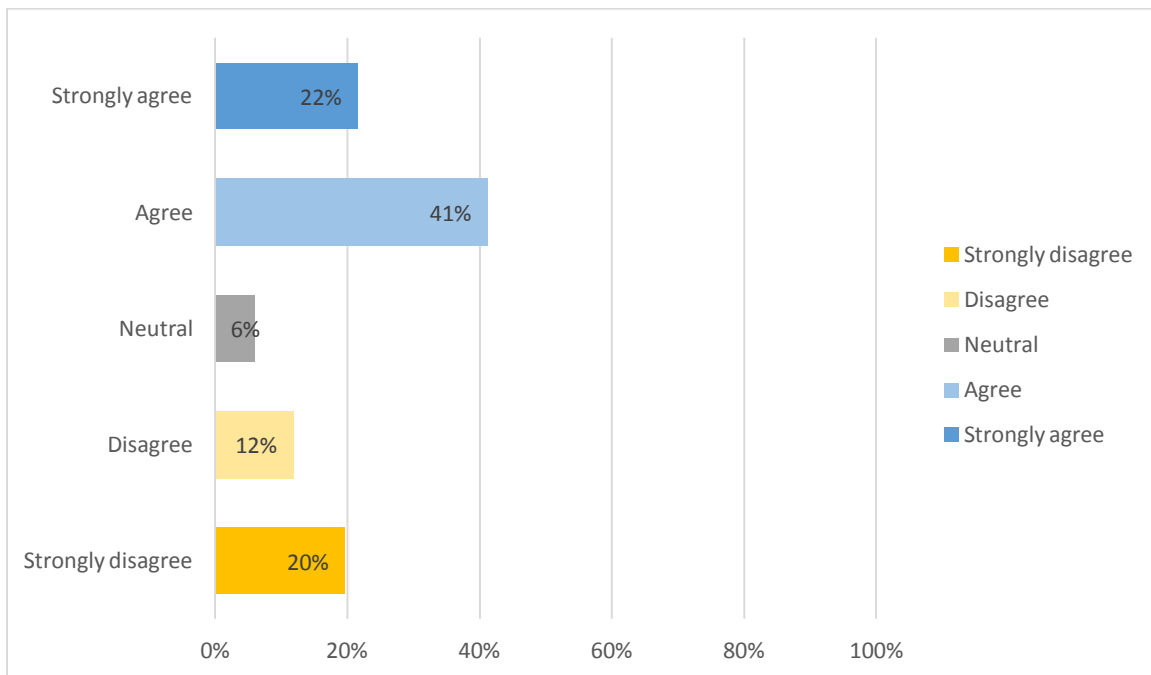
18. I do not think that migrants should have the same rights that I have on the work place.



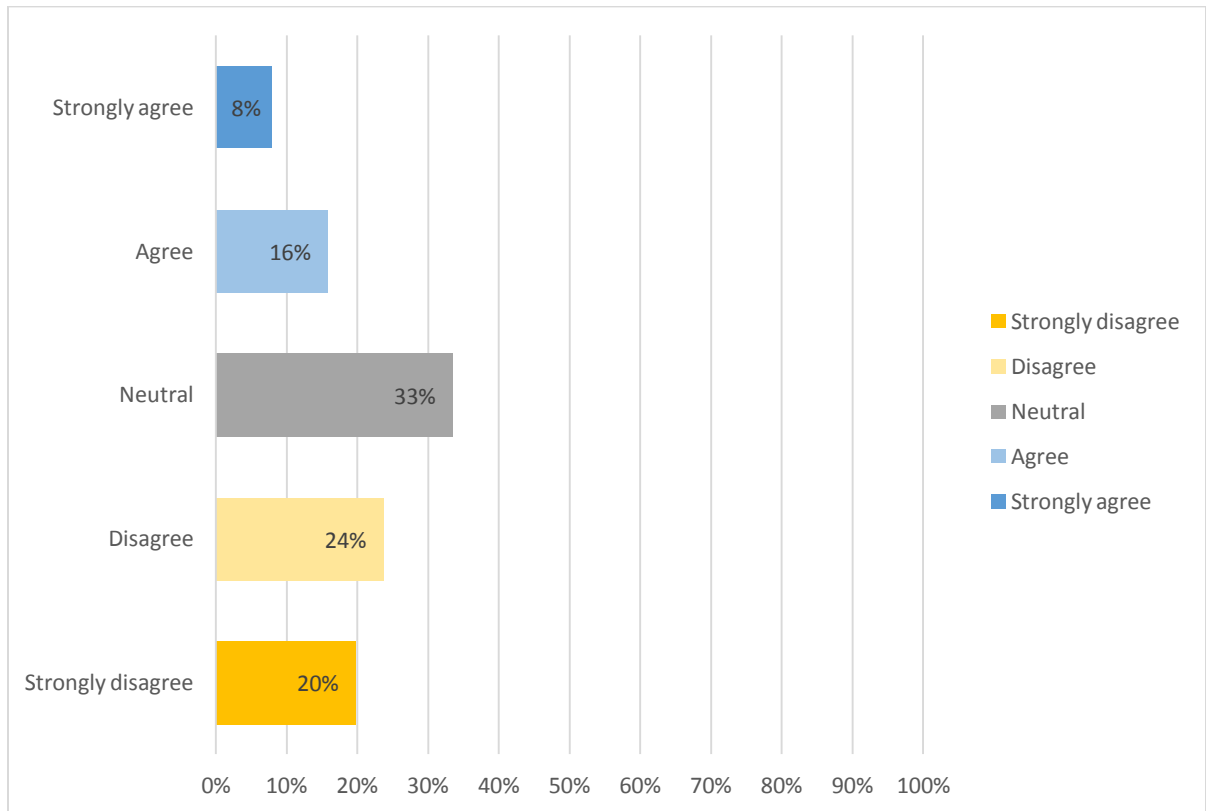
19. Migrants should have the right to vote in general elections, once they become Maltese citizens



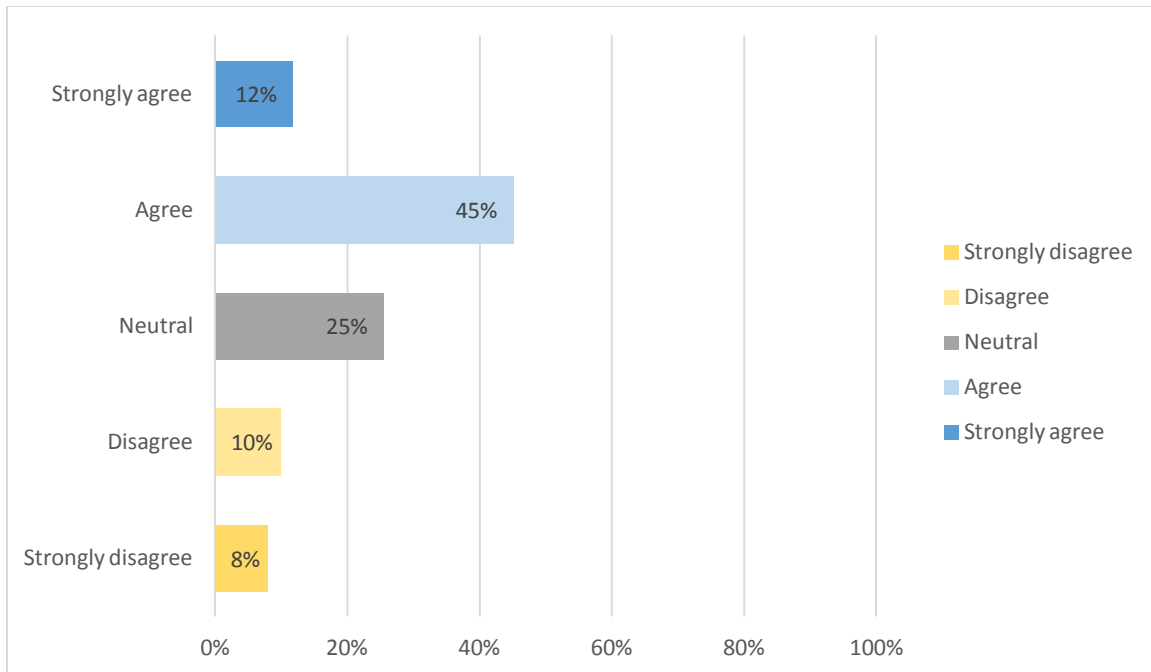
20. Migrants should not have access to free healthcare and other benefits.



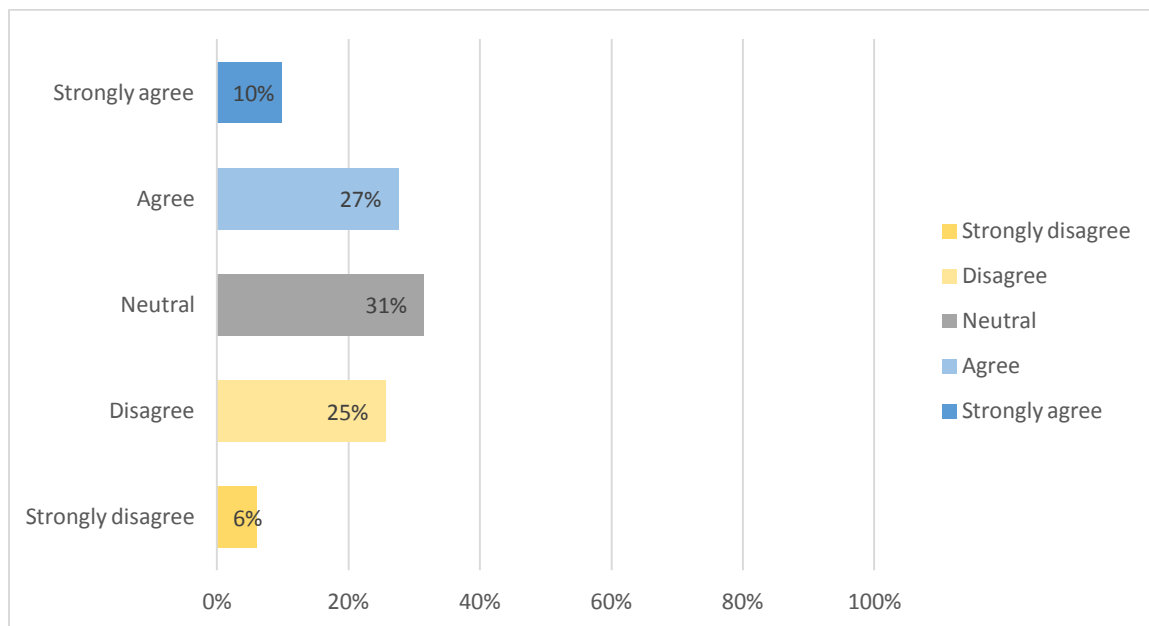
21. I would definitely choose a Maltese over a migrant for a job vacancy.



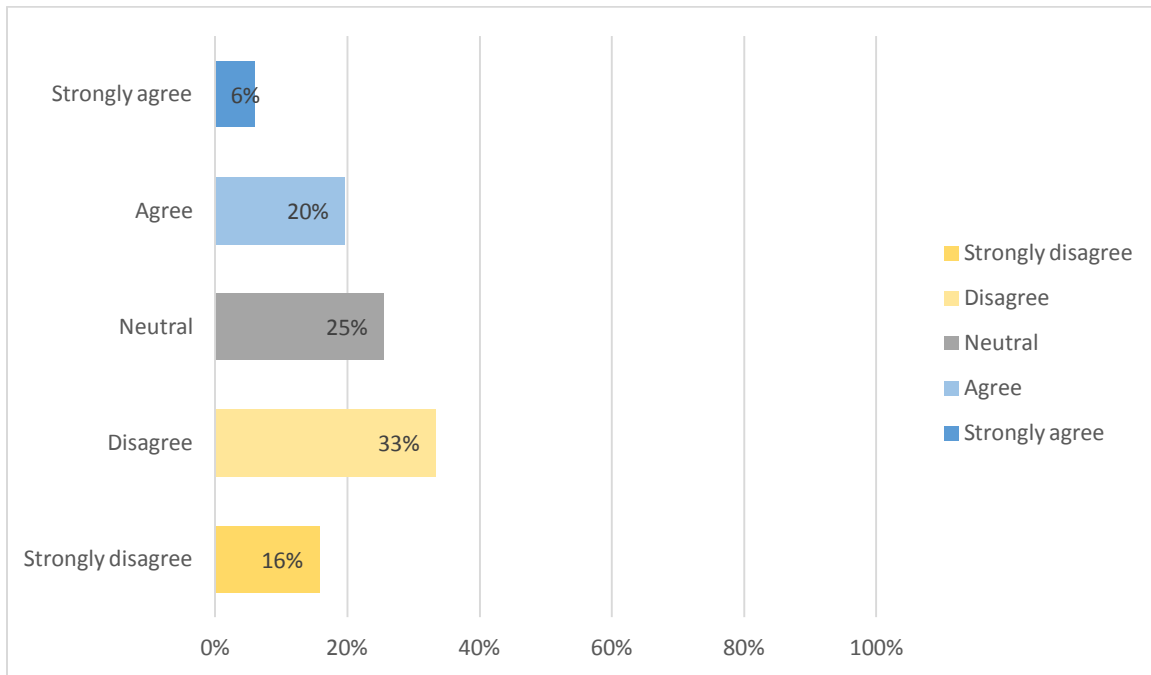
22. As a Maltese citizen I want to reach out to the migrants and find out more about them so as to be able to better understand their problems, their culture and share in our diversity.
